

**Invitation Letter to  
“APEC High Level Policy Dialogue on Education and  
Career Planning for Young Athletes”  
Self-Funded Project by Chinese Taipei**

I am writing to invite you to attend the “APEC High Level Policy Dialogue (HLPD) on Education and Career Planning for Young Athletes” and related meetings which will take place on 1<sup>st</sup>-2<sup>nd</sup> September 2016 in Taipei. The HLPD will take place at the Howard Plaza Hotel on September 1, 2016, which is open to the public. The APEC Sport Policy Network will be launched and only APEC members will be invited to this meeting at the Taiwan Institute of Economic Research on September 2, 2016.

The theme of HLPD is about advancing the education and career planning for young athletes. Thus it is linked with the theme of “Quality Growth and Human Development” that the APEC Host Economy for 2016, Peru, has chosen for this year. Moreover, the HLPD theme is in line with the APEC and HRDWG’s emphasis on the development of human capital. Before this, the 2014 APEC HRD Ministerial Meeting’s Action Plan (2015-2018) has called for strengthening economic opportunities for stakeholders, gender equity, youth employability, school to work transition, and education quality. Therefore, these issues are pertinent to young athletes. The HLPD will gather representatives of government, academia and business to discuss the best ways to provide education and career planning for young athletes.

At this stage, we are still developing the agenda. Please find attached the tentative agenda of the HLPD for your reference. We have organized the HLPD into three sessions: 1) Session 1: Policy Dialogue on Education of Young Athletes; 2) Session 2: APEC Economies’ Reports; and 3) Session 3: Public-Private-Partnership on Career Development.

In Session 1, the speakers will be high level government officials of sports from APEC economies. For Session 2, the presenters will be representatives of APEC members in general and APEC travel-eligible economies in particular. The speakers of Session 3 will be government officials, experts, and business representatives of APEC economies.

We would like to invite you to be a presenter in Session 2 (APEC Economies' Reports), sharing 10 minutes presentation of Indonesian policies and best practices of education and career planning for young athletes and elite athletes in particular. We will provide you with roundtrip economy class air tickets to Taipei and per diem from August 31 to September 3. The per diem will cover the cost of the hotel. Complimentary airport transportation will also be arranged.
